Executive Summary:

The PCC has received a request seeking a waiver of Contract Standing Orders. Surrey Police wishes to undertake urgent work to repair and replace vulnerable elements within the electrical infrastructure at Mount Browne Force Headquarters.

The PCC has been advised of the on-going work by Surrey Police to review the wider electrical infrastructure at HQ and of the likely risks if urgent work is not undertaken. The waiver seeks approval for three contractors to carry out the work – one to manage the project, one to undertake the electrical work and another to carry out associated building work. The total value of the work, which commence in May 2013, is £182,350.

Having considered the risks as set out in the report, the PCC agrees that this work should progress urgently. Full details of the waiver will be reported to the Joint Audit Committee meeting in June 2013, as required by Contract Standing Orders.

Recommendation

That a waiver to Contract Standing Orders is agreed to allow urgent work to be undertaken the electrical infrastructure at Mount Browne HQ.
