Executive Summary:

The PCC is already party to a Section 22A Collaboration Agreement, made pursuant to the Police Act 1996 (as amended) relating to the coordinating body known as the National Police Chiefs Council (NPCC). The NPCC is hosted by the Metropolitan Police. Following an independent review by legal experts and extensive consultation, a revised draft of the Agreement has been produced for signature.

The amendments are designed to better explain the arrangements for the delivery of the NPCC including governance, accountability and performance management. It was also important to ensure that any risks and liabilities faced by the host force are sufficiently mitigated in the Agreement.

That the Police & Crime Commissioner signs the Section 22A agreement in relation to the NPCC.
