Executive Summary:

The PCC has received a request to donate one of its fleet vehicles that has reached the end of its service to the Newwave in the Community charity. This will be used to carry equipment for its workshops and events.

There is no initial outlay for this vehicle. It is currently part of the fleet and will be replaced by a new vehicle. The only loss here would be the auction value of the vehicle that is donated which has been estimated to be £4,000 which will be shared by the PCC and force jointly. There will be no on-going costs to the police as these will be covered by Newwave. Full ownership will not be transferred for 2 years to prevent Newwave selling the vehicle on for profit.

- 2. Share the £4,000 loss of sales proceeds with the Force.
