Executive Summary:

Following the Surrey Child Sexual Exploitation Awareness event held on 18th March 2016, the PCC is to make a £10,000 contribution to the Breck Foundation, to support work aimed at increasing children's understanding of playing safe whilst using the internet.

The CSE event brought together partners and parents to help prevent CSE in Surrey and raise awareness of how it affects boys and young men. Lorin LaFave, whose teenage son Breck Bednar was tragically murdered by a man he met online, addressed the event and is now spearheading work through the Breck Foundation to promote online safety messages.
