Executive Summary:

The PCC has received a request to donate one of its fleet vehicles that has reached the end of its service to the Surrey Scouts Event Support Unit. The vehicle would be used as a first aid treatment area, radio communications centre, for staff welfare and equipment transportation. The Surrey Scouts are a registered charity and the Events Unit's primary function is to support any Scout or Guide event in the County. The vehicle would also be used to assist at events and activities at the Bentley Copse Outdoor Activity Centre for not only Scouts and Guides but other young people from various schools, clubs and other groups across Surrey.

There is no initial outlay for this vehicle. It is currently part of the fleet and will be replaced by a new vehicle. The only loss here would be the auction value of the vehicle that is donated which has been estimated to be £3,750. There will be no on-going costs to the police as the vehicle will be gifted to the Surrey Scouts. Once this has happened then the usual agreement is that the vehicle is registered to the Scouts but full ownership is not transferred until 2 full years have passed. This negates any chance of the Scouts simply selling the vehicle on for profit.

There is no request for funding on this report; rather this is a simple request for one ex-fleet vehicle to be gifted to the Surrey Scouts.
