**Notice of Completion of the Audit of Accounts year ended 31 March 2020**

1. NOTICE is hereby given that Mark Hodgson, for and on behalf of Ernst & Young LLP, One Cambridge Business Park, Cowley Road, Cambridge, CB4 0WZ has completed the audit of the accounts of the PCC and CC for the year ended 31 March 2020.
2. An unqualified opinion, the independent auditors report including a conclusion on arrangements for securing economy, efficiency and effectiveness in the use of resources were issued by Mr Hodgson on 30 November 2020 in accordance with Section 18(1)(b) of the Local Government Finance Act 1982.
3. During the period from 7 August 2020 to 18 September 2020, members of the public and local government electors had rights in the audit process in accordance with Section 25 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014 to:
  - Inspect and make copies of the accounts for the year ended 31 March 2020 and certain related documents.
  - Ask the auditor questions about the accounts.
  - Make an objection to the accounts concerning matters where the auditor could issue a report in the public interest (under section 27 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014) and/or apply to the court for a declaration that an item in the accounts is contrary to law (under section 28 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014).
