Executive Summary:

The PCC is asked to authorise the entering into of the above S.22A agreement, for the procurement and delivery of forensic and analytical services to the West and Southern Coast Consortium ('WSCC'). That this is an extension of an existing agreement and there are no significant changes to the content in this renewal.

Background

A previous S22A agreement was entered into in 2008 for the establishment of the West and Southern Coast Consortium (WSCC) with the aim of providing a collaborative arrangement relating to the procurement and delivery of forensic and analytical services. The lead policing body has given notice that it and the lead chief officer wish to withdraw from their roles as lead parties. The original collaboration arrangement will manage the existing contracts for 19 forces until the conclusion of those contracts on 30th June 2022. This new S22A agreement appoints a replacement lead policing body and lead chief officer.
